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DEMONS

FORWARD:

Having been a Christian for 26 years, and still being very naïve about “Demons”; Timothy II embarked on two Crusades to the Philippines. He soon found himself in ‘Spiritual Warfare’ as he never thought possible.

The very first deliverance came, when he and the Company that went with him, were asked to pray for a young woman’s drug addiction. Much to their surprise, “Demons” manifested themselves in her, and the prayer turned into a deliverance.

The young lady was totally delivered and set free from drugs.

The same story repeated itself throughout the Crusades.

Timothy II was then invited to the island of Mindoro. Here it was that he encountered the “Devil” himself. Even to this day, the Lord has not allowed the full story to be told on what happened on Mindoro.

Suffice it to say, that Timothy II learned many things about ‘Spiritual Warfare’ unknown to him, through this encounter.

One of the most important things that the Lord revealed through this encounter is the use of “Holy Anointing Oil” in deliverances. (Mark 6:13)

On a mountain on Mindoro, while pouring Oil out upon it, the Lord gave Timothy II a “Vision”. The “Vision” showed how the “Holy Anointing Oil” became as “licking, burning flames of fire”, as it rolled down the mountain; much like a volcano with hot lava. The “Demons” had to flee from the mountain because they couldn’t stand the “burning flames”. They couldn’t stop or set down.

The Scriptures the Lord gave with this “Vision” are: (Isaiah 14:24-27)

Upon arriving back in the United States, the Lord gave Timothy II a formula from which to make the “Holy Anointing Oil”.

This is not to suggest that this is some magic formula, but just as the Lord commanded His “Holy Anointing Oil” to be made in (Exodus 30:23-25), so was Timothy II to do today.

We give this “Holy Anointing Oil” away free of charge to Christian Leaders, and the formula is no secret.

(Read the Study Guide on “Fresh Holy Anointing Oil” by Timothy II).

Remember, it is not the Oil that contains the “Power” to deliver, but the “Holy Spirit” doing His work through us. (Matthew 12:28) It is however, a point of contact.

God has been having us use the “Holy Anointing Oil” in all deliverances of “Demon Possessed” people. It doesn’t matter whether they are satanic priests, devil worshippers, or drug addicts, etc., they can all be delivered.

One time while delivering a drug addict who was a very big man, the man tried to attack Timothy II. He knocked the Anointing Oil out of his hand, and with ‘two team members’ hanging onto his arms he lunged at Timothy II. Just before he got to him, the Oil was recovered, and Timothy II put it on his forehead. He immediately became docile, and was soon totally delivered. After it was all over, he cried like a baby in Timothy II’s arms.

(Mark 5:2, 3, 4, 15)

We cannot explain why or how all this works, but we do know that God is doing a ‘New Thing’ which is really an ‘Old Thing’, and will use anyone available. (Mark 1:26, 27) This work with “Demons” is not enjoyable, nor fun in human terms; however, the pleasure you get, is knowing that the person is truly ‘Saved’, once they are delivered and accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. This is cause for the angels in heaven to rejoice. (Luke 15:7, 10)

Timothy II once asked the Lord if he might have a ‘Healing’ ministry like Benny Hinn’s, instead of doing all these deliverances.

The Lord told him no, because deliverances are more important than healings; because when the person gets Saved after the deliverance, it is Eternal. When a person gets healed, it is only temporary!

TIMOTHY II

DEMONS

I. DEMON POSSESSION:

Demon: Daimon in the Greek - Is a "Demon" or 'supernatural spirit' of a bad nature.

Possess: The dictionary says, to possess, is to "enter into and control".

(Read Matthew 4:24 8:16, 28, 33 9:32 Mark 1:32 5:15, 16 Luke 8:36 Acts 16:16)

WHAT IS IT?

"Demon Possession" is the control of a person's behavior by a 'spirit' that is **in** them.

It is recognizable by the person's bizarre behavior, and can usually be seen by looking directly into the person's eyes. Sometimes you can smell the "Demons".

Many times these "Demon Possessed" people talk about religious things and know the Bible well; however, their thought patterns don't make sense.

Their attitudes are often belligerent and haughty. (Luke 4:34)

Sometimes these "Demons" have been established through 'Generations' and are very difficult to deliver. Even young children can be "Demon" Possessed." (Mark 9:21)

The person that has "Demons", must be willing and want to be delivered before you can have success in helping them; unless, of course, God sovereignly works in the person's life to deliver them.

Usually we can tell when a person is "Demon Possessed", because we will feel uneasy or troubled in our 'Spirit'. Sometimes we actually get sick to our stomach, when around these people.

II. CHRISTIAN ATTRIBUTES NEEDED TO FIGHT DEMONS:

ONE MUST BE A MATURE CHRISTIAN:

A person needs to be a 'Mature Christian' before they can really discern the difference between good and evil. Therefore, a 'novice' should not attempt to become involved with "Demonic" activity or knowledge.

Heb 5:13-14

13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.

14 **But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.**

BE BAPTIZED (FILLED) WITH THE HOLY GHOST:

Jesus said that “casting out devils” is a miracle (Mark 9:38, 39), and miracles are a ‘Charisma Gift’ of the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 12:10).

Before trying to do a deliverance, a Christian should be ‘Baptized (filled) with the Holy Ghost’, and needs the “Gifts” of ‘miracles’, and ‘discerning of spirits’.

Being ‘Baptized with the Holy Ghost’ also gives us the “Power” to cast out “Demons”.

Acts 1:5

5 For John truly baptized with water; but **ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost** not many days hence.

Acts 1:8

8 But **ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you:** and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

MUST HAVE THE GIFT OF DISCERNING OF SPIRITS:

By using the ‘Charisma Gift’ of “Discerning of spirits”, we can know who and what we are dealing with.

If you want this “Gift of the Holy Spirit”, you must ask for it. (Luke 11:13)

Also, you must have the right motives. (Acts 8:18 1Corinthians 14:12)

The Bible teaches:

1 Cor 12:1

1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant.

1 Cor 12:7-8

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

1 Cor 12:10-11

10 To another the **working of miracles**; to another prophecy; **to another discerning of spirits**; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

1 Cor 12:31

31 But **covet earnestly the best gifts:** ...

ONE MUST TRY (TEST) THE SPIRITS:

The ‘Mature Christian’ needs to try (test) the ‘spirits’, whether they are of God.

The spirit **in** the person must confess that Jesus Christ came in the flesh before you are sure it is the ‘Spirit of God’!

I Jn 4:1-2

1 **Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God:** because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

2 **Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:**

III. HOW TO DO A DELIVERANCE:

“Demon Possessed” people need to be delivered, and although every situation is unique, the following methods have seemed to work the best:

EYE CONTACT:

Always stay focused and always keep your eyes **fixed** on the eyes of the person being delivered. Never lose eye contact or turn away, but maintain eye contact with the person, as you are ‘binding and casting’ the “Demons” out **in** the ‘Name of Jesus’.

Pry their eyes open if you have to, but don’t lose eye contact.

Acts 13:9-10

9 Then Saul, (who also is called **Paul**,) **filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,**

10 **And said,** O full of all subtilty and all mischief, **thou child of the devil,** thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

BINDING & LOOSENING:

Speak to the ‘spirits’ in general, and say, “I bind you and cast you out in Jesus’ Name”. (Matthew 16:19)

Matt 18:18

18 Verily I say unto you, **Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**

CALLING THE SPIRITS OUT:

Call the ‘spirits’ out individually by one of the 14 names, as the Holy Spirit leads.

Say, “Come out you spirit of _____”.

Many times the person will blink their eyes as each “Demon” departs; however, the tougher ones sometime come out with growling or a loud voice. (Mark 9:26)

Don’t stop until you are sure they are **all** out.

Don’t call out ‘spirits’ that aren’t there, or are not ‘spirits’.

(Read the tract on the “Foul spirits of Satan)

If you are not sure which ‘spirits’ to call out, then call out all the “Foul spirits of Satan”. (Mark 9:25)

ANOINT WITH OIL:

As a final measure of deliverance, anoint the person's forehead with "Holy Anointing Oil". This "Holy Anointing Oil", which includes the "Holy Perfume", acts as a hot fire and causes the "Demons" to jump out. Sometimes we put the Oil under their nose, and the smell (or fumigation) of the "Holy Perfume" helps drive the "Demons" out.

They don't understand it, and they can't handle it. (Exodus 30:29 Leviticus 8:12 Isaiah 14:24-27)

The following is the meaning of the 'Holy Perfume' in Hebrew:

7004 qetoreth (ket-o'-reth);

from 6999; **a fumigation:**

KJV-- (sweet) incense, **perfume.**

6999 qatar (kaw-tar');)

a primitive root [identical with 7000 through **the idea of fumigation in a close place and perhaps thus driving out the occupants**]; to smoke, i.e. turn into fragrance by fire (especially as an act of worship):

KJV-- burn (incense, sacrifice) (upon), (altar for) incense, kindle, offer (incense, a sacrifice).

USE THE FINGER:

Use your index finger to 'anoint' the person's forehead.

Luke 11:20

20 **But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.**

PRAY THE SINNER'S PRAYER:

Once a "Demon Possessed" person is delivered, they **must** immediately be led in the 'Sinner's Prayer' for Salvation. It doesn't matter how many times they have prayed the 'Sinner's Prayer' before, nor how long they think they have been a Christian.

If you do not, the state of the person will be worse than before.

Matt 12:43-45

43 **When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.**

44 **Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished.**

45 **Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.**

THE BAPTISM (FILLING) WITH THE HOLY GHOST:

If the Lord leads you to pray for a person being delivered to receive the 'Baptism with the Holy Ghost', do it after the deliverance has been completed.

A person cannot receive the 'Baptism with the Holy Ghost' until all "Demons" are gone and the person has received Jesus as their Lord and Savior! (Acts 9:17-18)

Acts 8:15

15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

Acts 8:17

17 Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

Acts 19:6

6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

FALLING DOWN:

Don't let the person fall down during the deliverance. The "Demons" will do this to hide from you, and to lose eye contact. However, after they pray the 'Sinner's Prayer', most people 'will' fall down under the "Power" of the "Holy Spirit". Some will automatically receive the 'Baptism with the Holy Ghost' while on the ground.

THE NAME OF JESUS:

Always cast the "Demons" out **in** the "Name of Jesus". This is a must!

Mark 16:17

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; **In my name shall they cast out devils; ...**

THE PIT:

Send the "Demons" to the 'Pit' as you cast them out, so that they will not go into someone else or something else. (Luke 8:32-33)

Say something like, "I cast you out and send you to the Pit", or "go to the Pit in Jesus' Name". (Revelation 20:1, 3)

Luke 8:31

31 **And they besought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep.**

The word 'deep' means the following in the Greek:

12 abussos (ab'-us-sos);

from 1 (as a negative particle) and a variation of 1037; **depthless**, i.e. (specially)

(infernally) "**abyss**":

KJV-- **deep, (bottomless) pit.**

IV. OTHER HELPFUL TIPS:

ALWAYS PRAY WITH TWO OR THREE PARTNERS:

Whenever possible, you should work with 2 or 3 people in doing deliverances.

There are several reasons why:

One is you may need to hold onto the person in case they become violent; the second is the others can help you discern what “Demons” to call out. Another reason is that you will have the confidence that Jesus is there with you.

Matt 18:19-20

19 Again I say unto you, That **if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.**

20 **For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.**

COMMAND BY AUTHORITY:

Jesus has given all His Saints exousia power (Delegated Authority) over all “Demons”. Therefore, when doing a deliverance, ‘Command’ the “Demons” to come out in the ‘Name of Jesus’. Use a firm and somewhat loud voice. Do not try to discuss or argue with them. If need be, tell them to **shut up!**

Mark 1:25

25 **And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.**

Luke 9:1

1 **Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.**

Luke 10:19

19 **Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.**

James 2:19

19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: **the devils also believe, and tremble.**

SET AN APPOINTMENT:

Whenever possible, set an appointment for the person to be delivered. It will give them an anticipation that something good will happen, and help to build their faith.

It will also allow time to see if they are serious about wanting the “Demons” out, and give you and them time to ‘Fast and Pray’.

When coming to a church for the deliverance, it is sometimes good to have them attend the Service and then do the deliverance. This can help with the anticipation of what God is going to do.

FASTING AND PRAYER:

Always Fast and Pray’ before attempting to do a deliverance. Some ‘spirits’ only come out by ‘Prayer and Fasting’. (Mark 9:29)

Also, having the person fast, may keep them from ‘throwing up’ on you.

Matt 17:21

21 Howbeit **this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.**

BE IN AGREEMENT:

Even though the person being delivered has no ‘authority’ to cast out the “Demons”, (Acts 19:15); having the person agree and express wanting them out, seems to help shake up the “Demons”. They know that this person means business.

HEALINGS:

Sometimes people are healed from their ‘physical infirmities’ when delivered. This is because the “spirit of Infirmity” may be present in the person, and when it comes out they get healed.

Matt 8:16

16 When the even was come, they brought unto him **many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:**

Acts 8:7

7 **For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.**

PRAISE & THANKSGIVING:

Sometimes ‘praise and thanksgiving’ music may be used to bring in the “presence of the Lord”, to help prepare the people for the deliverance. This is particularly true in a church setting.

1 Sam 16:23

23 And it came to pass, **when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.**

TIME:

Deliverances are sometimes instantaneous.

Most deliverance’s however, take time, usually from 15 minutes to one hour.

If it takes hours, it may mean the person doesn’t really want to be delivered.

Instead of spending hours trying to deliver that person, it is usually better to stop and try at another time.

God will sometimes deliver people even when they do not want to be delivered.

(Mark 1:23-26)

Acts 16:18

18 And this did she many days. But **Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.**

LEGIONS:

Sometimes people have ‘legions’ of “Demons”, which means large numbers. When “legions” are involved it usually takes somewhat longer to do the deliverance. We have delivered as many as ‘ten legions’ out of one person.

Mark 5:9

9 And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, **My name is Legion: for we are many.**

Mark 5:15

15 And they come to Jesus, and see **him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion**, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Luke 8:30

30 And Jesus asked him, saying, **What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.**

WHEN ALL ELSE FAILS:**PLEAD THE BLOOD:**

In difficult situations, “plead the Blood of Jesus Christ”.

Rom 5:9

9 Much more then, **being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath** through him.

Eph 1:7

7 **In whom we have redemption through his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Col 1:13-14

13 **Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness**, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

14 **In whom we have redemption through his blood**, even the forgiveness of sins:

AND / OR PRAY IN TONGUES:

When nothing seems to be working, “Pray in tongues”. This will allow the Holy Spirit to make intercession for us, when we know not what to pray for.

It is especially important in foreign countries to “Pray in tongues” when all else fails. It is our experience that some “Demons” speak in foreign languages and if you do not have an interpreter, ‘speaking in tongues’ can help in deliverances.

Rom 8:26-27

26 **Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities** (weaknesses): **for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.**

27 **And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.**

V. THE FOURTEEN DEMONIC SPIRITS OF THE BIBLE:

The Bible teaches that there are basically 14 “Demonic spirits” that “possess” people. These “Demons” or ‘spirits’, lead people into sinful ‘habits’, and wreck havoc on their lives. They need to be ‘cast out’!

Many sinful ‘habits’, however, can come from ‘pride’ and/or the ‘works of the flesh’, not “Demons”. (Ezekiel 16:49-50 Galatians 5:19-21)

It is a waste of time to call out these ‘habits’ as “Demons”.

The people with these ‘habits’ need to “Repent” of these ‘sins’ and get some Godly counseling. (Isaiah 30:1)

For Example:

Some people call out the “Demons” of alcohol and drugs. The Bible states that the use of alcohol and drugs are ‘sins’ and the ‘works of the flesh’, and not “Demons”. Therefore, a deliverance is not necessary. (Galatians 5:20-21)

Sometimes the “spirit of Bondage” **does** have control over people with severe habits, and they need to be delivered from this “Demon”.

Some people call out the ‘spirit’ of religion or idolatry. These are also ‘works of the flesh’, and are usually caused by ‘pride’. (Galatians 5:20)

A religious attitude or idolatry can however, be caused by the “spirit of Whoredoms”, and this “Demon” needs to be cast out.

The “spirit of Whoredoms” can also cause sexual perversion; but usually, this too is a ‘work of the flesh’. (Galatians 5:19)

Some of the “Fourteen Demonic spirits” that are the hardest to cast out, are the ‘unclean’, ‘deaf & dumb’, ‘blind’, and ‘divination’. The others come out easier; however, they will sometimes ‘bundle’ together to resist more, but it doesn’t help them if you keep persisting.

FOUL SPIRITS:

This is a general term for all “Demonic spirits”.

When doing a ‘deliverance’, you can say: “Come out you ‘Foul spirits of Satan”.

This is particularly helpful, if you do not know which ‘spirits’ to cast out.

Mark 9:25

25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked **the foul spirit**, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, **come out of him**, and enter no more into him.

Rev 18:2

2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of **every foul spirit**, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

1. UNCLEAN SPIRITS:

“Unclean spirits” are sometimes very hard to cast out. (Luke 9:37-42)

There can be many in one person. (Legions) (Mark 5:9, 15 Luke 8:30)

Those ‘Possessed’ by these “Demons” can be strong and violent. (Luke 8:29)

“Unclean spirits” are the ones that can lead to homosexuality, when it isn’t a ‘work of the flesh’. (Romans 1:26-27 Jude 7)

These ‘spirits’ will sometimes try to harass you vocally and threaten you, but they can’t harm you.

We have found it is important to ‘Fast and Pray’ before attempting to deliver these ‘spirits’.

Matt 10:1 (Mark 6:7)

1 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, **he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out**, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Mark 1:23-27 (Luke 4:33)

23 And there was in their synagogue **a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out**,

24 **Saying, Let us alone**; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.

25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.

26 And when **the unclean spirit** had torn him, and **cried with a loud voice**, he came out of him.

27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine is this? for with authority commandeth he even **the unclean spirits**, and they do obey him.

Mark 3:11

11 And **unclean spirits**, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the Son of God.

Mark 5:2-6

2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs **a man with an unclean spirit**,

3 Who had his dwelling among the tombs; and **no man could bind him**, no, not with chains:

4 Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any man tame him.

5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.

6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him,

Mark 5:8

8 For **he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.**

Mark 5:12-13

12 **And all the devils besought him, saying, Send us into the swine,** that we may enter into them.

13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. **And the unclean spirits** went out, and **entered into the swine:** and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, **(they were about two thousand;)** and were choked in the sea.

Mark 7:25-30

25 For a certain woman, whose **young daughter had an unclean spirit,** heard of him, and came and fell at his feet:

26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and **she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.**

27 But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs.

28 And she answered and said unto him, Yes, Lord: yet the dogs under the table eat of the children's crumbs.

29 **And he said unto her,** For this saying **go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.**

30 **And** when she was come to her house, **she found the devil gone out,** and her daughter laid upon the bed.

Acts 5:16

16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and **them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed** every one.

Acts 8:7

7 **For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them:** and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Rev 16:13

13 **And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth** of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

2. FAMILIAR SPIRITS:

“Familiar spirits” come in a variety of types. Suffice it to say they are easy to recognize, because the person that has them is usually very flighty. They can’t stay still.

They particularly can’t look at you in the face. These ‘spirits’ come out very easily. Many times they are bound together with the “spirit of Divination”.

Some of the people that have “Familiar spirits” are the ones that people in the world go to, in order to get counsel or to know the future (astrologers, diviners, enchanters, mediums, psychics, spiritists, witches, wizards, etc.).

Lev 19:31

31 **Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards**, to be defiled by them: I am the LORD your God.

Lev 20:6

6 **And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards**, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

Lev 20:27

27 **A man also or woman that hath a familiar spirit, or that is a wizard**, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood shall be upon them.

Deut 18:10-12

10 **There shall not be found among you any one** that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or **that useth divination**, or **an observer of times**, or **an enchanter**, or **a witch**,

11 **Or a charmer**, or **a consulter with familiar spirits**, or **a wizard**, or **a necromancer**.

12 **For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD**: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee.

1 Sam 28:7-8

7 **Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit**, that I may go to her, and inquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, **there is a woman that hath a familiar spirit** at Endor.

8 **And Saul disguised himself**, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: **and he said**, I pray thee, **divine unto me by the familiar spirit**, and bring me him up, whom I shall name unto thee.

II Ki 21:6

6 **And he made his son pass through the fire**, and **observed times**, and used **enchantments**, and **dealt with familiar spirits** and **wizards**: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

II Ki 23:24

24 **Moreover the workers with familiar spirits**, and **the wizards**, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiyah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

2 Chr 33:6

6 And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also **he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards:** he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

Isa 8:19

19 And when they shall say unto you, **Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards** that peep, and that mutter: **should not a people seek unto their God?** for the living to the dead?

Isa 19:3

3 And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and **they shall seek** to the idols, and to **the charmers, and to them that have familiar spirits, and to the wizards.**

Some with “Familiar spirits” can throw their voice like a ventriloquist, so it sounds as if it is coming from another place.

Isa 29:4

4 And thou shalt be brought down, and shalt speak out of the ground, and thy speech shall be low out of the dust, and **thy voice shall be, as of one that hath a familiar spirit, out of the ground, and thy speech shall whisper out of the dust.**

3. SPIRIT OF DIVINATION:

The “spirit of Divination” is stronger than “Familiar spirits”. It is a little more difficult to ‘cast out’ and will sometimes resist you vocally.

This “Demon” many times works through ‘flattery’ by an individual. However, they usually overdo it, which makes you suspicious of the motives of the individual. (Psalms 12:3 Proverbs 26:28 1 Thessalonians 2:5)

The people who have a “spirit of Divination” will also speak through lies and deceit. Many use Divination for the gain of filthy lucre (money).

Acts 16:16-18

16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, **a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination** met us, which **brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:**

17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

18 And this did she many days. **But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.** And he came out the same hour.

Deut 18:10

10 **There shall not be found among you any one** that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or **that useth divination,** or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch,

Jer 29:8

8 For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; **Let not your prophets and your diviners**, that be in the midst of you, **deceive you**, neither hearken to your dreams which ye cause to be dreamed.

Ezek 12:24

24 **For there shall be no more any vain vision nor flattering divination** within the house of Israel.

Ezek 13:7

7 Have ye not seen a vain vision, and **have ye not spoken a lying divination**, whereas ye say, The LORD saith it; albeit I have not spoken?

Ezek 13:9

9 **And mine hand shall be upon the prophets** that see vanity, and **that divine lies**: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.

Ezek 13:23

23 **Therefore ye shall see no more vanity**, nor **divine divinations**: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Micah 3:11

11 The heads thereof judge for reward, and the priests thereof teach for hire, and **the prophets thereof divine for money**: yet will they lean upon the LORD, and say, Is not the LORD among us? none evil can come upon us.

4. DEAF & DUMB SPIRITS:

We have learned through experience that “Deaf and Dumb spirits” ‘should’ be the first ones you ‘cast out’. If you don’t, and the person has them, they will shut the ears of the person so the ‘spirits’ and the person can’t hear you’. The results will be that they won’t come out.

When we have had difficult deliverances, this has many times been the problem.

“Deaf and Dumb spirits” will also not come out except by “Prayer and Fasting”.

Even Jesus’ disciples couldn’t cast them out.

This is why it is important to “Fast and Pray” before you go to minister everywhere the Holy Spirit leads you. You never know when you might have to do a deliverance.

(Matthew 17:21)

The “Dumb spirits” can also stop the person from praying the ‘Sinner’s Prayer’. If they cannot repeat the prayer, you know the person has not yet been delivered.

Sometimes when these “Deaf and Dumb spirits” come out, they do so violently, causing the person to fall down and become exhausted afterwards. Don’t let this bother you, but just wait and give them time to recover.

Mark 9:17-18

17 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, **I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;**

18 And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and **I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.**

Mark 9:20

20 And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, **straightway the spirit tare him;** and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming.

Mark 9:23-29

23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.

25 When **Jesus** saw that the people came running together, he **rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.**

26 **And the spirit cried, and rent him sore,** and came out of him: **and he was as one dead;** insomuch that many said, He is dead.

27 **But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up;** and he arose.

28 And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

29 **And he said** unto them, **This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.**

5. EVIL SPIRITS:

“Evil spirits” are ‘small bundles of spirits’. They are not powerful; however, you better know Jesus as your Lord and Savior before you try to ‘cast them out’.

Notice here, that when a person is ‘delivered’ from “Evil spirits”, they are considered to be cured or healed, just like from any other disease.

Acts 19:15

15 **And the evil spirit** answered and said, **Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?**

Luke 7:21

21 **And in that same hour he cured many** of their infirmities and plagues, **and of evil spirits;** and unto many that were blind he gave sight.

Luke 8:2

2 **And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits** and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, **out of whom went seven devils,**

Paul delivered “Evil spirits” out of some by the sending of handkerchiefs, which the Bible calls ‘Special Miracles’.

Acts 19:11-12

11 **And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:**

12 **So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.**

6. THE SPIRIT OF WHOREDOMS:

The “spirit of Whoredoms”, can cause two types of ‘Whoredoms’, one ‘spiritual’ and the other ‘physical’. The ‘spiritual’ Whoredoms lead to idolatry (Exodus 34:14-16 Ezekiel 14:3-5), and the ‘physical’ Whoredoms lead to sexual perversion. (Ezekiel 16:36)

Although sexual perversion such as adultery, fornication, pornography, etc., is usually a ‘lust of the flesh’, a “spirit of Whoredoms” can sometimes be the root cause.

(1 Corinthians 6:18 1 Timothy 1:8-10 Revelation 2:20)

Ezek 16:17

17 Thou hast also taken thy fair jewels of my gold and of my silver, which I had given thee, **and madest to thyself images of men, and didst commit whoredom with them,**

Hosea 4:12-13

12 My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: **for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused them to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God.**

13 They sacrifice upon the tops of the mountains, and burn incense upon the hills, under oaks and poplars and elms, because the shadow thereof is good: **therefore your daughters shall commit whoredom, and your spouses shall commit adultery.**

Hosea 5:4

4 They will not frame their doings to turn unto their God: **for the spirit of whoredoms is in the midst of them,** and they have not known the LORD.

7. THE SPIRIT OF JEALOUSY:

The “spirit of Jealousy” is a major cause of divorce. It causes a person to not trust anyone, and to be suspicious of everyone and everything. If the “spirit of Jealousy” is allowed to continue **in** a person, the person will become violent and have fits of rage and anger. (Proverbs 29:22)

Be cautious when doing a deliverance with this ‘Demon’. Be sure to have your helpers with you to help control this person, as this person sometimes becomes violent. Even though they cannot succeed, they may try to hurt you.

After this person is delivered from this “Demon”, they must be taught that it takes time for them to become adjusted to normal anger that all of us have experienced. They must learn to deal with it gradually. (Ephesians 4:26)

Num 5:14

14 **And the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife,** and she be defiled: **or if the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife,** and she be not defiled:

Num 5:30

30 Or **when the spirit of jealousy** cometh upon him, **and he be jealous over his wife**, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law.

Prov 6:34

34 **For jealousy is the rage of a man:** therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance.

Song 8:6

6 Set me as a seal upon thine heart, as a seal upon thine arm: for love is strong as death; **jealousy is cruel as the grave: the coals thereof are coals of fire, which hath a most vehement flame.**

8. THE SPIRIT OF BONDAGE:

The “spirit of Bondage” can cause us to have a ‘fear’ of falling back into our old lifestyle. When this happens, we need to cast out the “spirit of Bondage” as well as the “spirit of Fear”.

The “spirit of Bondage” is the “Demon” that can cause us to become ‘addicted’ to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, etc., and needs to be ‘cast out’. However, the ‘works of the flesh’ usually causes these ‘addictions’. (Galatians 5:19-20)

Sometimes the person with this “Demon” will also have “Generational Curses”, and this must be broken.

Rom 8:15

15 **For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear;** but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Gal 5:1

1 **Stand fast therefore** in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, **and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.**

2 Pet 2:1

1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as **there shall be false teachers among you**, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

2 Pet 2:19-20

19 **While they promise them liberty**, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, **of the same is he brought in bondage.**

20 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

Gal 2:4

4 And that because of **false brethren unawares brought in**, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, **that they might bring us into bondage:**

9. THE SPIRIT OF FEAR:

The “spirit of Fear” is one of the worst “Demons” because it causes torment, and deprives a person of their love and joy. If it is allowed to continue the person will begin to lose sleep, and their health will deteriorate. (Proverbs 17:22)

This can lead to deep depression and thoughts of suicide.

Although this “Demon” comes out relatively easy, the person has a hard time believing it is gone. It takes time for them to regain their confidence.

They shouldn’t be left alone, and they need activities to keep them mentally and emotionally occupied until they become stable.

Love is the important ingredient.

As Christians, we do not have the “spirit of Fear”, so if we Fear, we are not yet perfected in God’s Love!

2 Tim 1:7

7 **For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

I Jn 4:18

18 **There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.**

Ps 27:1

1 **The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?**

Prov 1:33

33 **But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.**

Rev 21:8

8 **But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.**

10. THE SPIRIT OF INFIRMITY:

The “spirit of Infirmity” is the cause of many people’s sicknesses and infirmities. When a person is ‘Possessed’ with this “Demon”, and they are delivered, they usually get healed from their infirmities. We have seen people healed when we did not even call out the “spirit of Infirmity”. It just came out with other “Demons”.

Although, Christians are not ‘Possessed’ with “Demons”, they can be ‘Seduced’ by them. When this happens with the “spirit of Infirmity”, Christians **can** become ill. To be released from this ‘Seducing spirit’, you just say: **“I loosen you spirit of Infirmity in the Name of Jesus”**. It ‘must’ go!

Luke 13:11-13

11 And, behold, **there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity** eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

12 And when **Jesus saw her**, he called her to him, **and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.**

13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

John 5:5

5 **And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.**

John 5:8-9

8 **Jesus saith unto him, Rise**, take up thy bed, and walk.

9 **And immediately the man was made whole**, and took up his bed, and walked:...

Matt 8:17

17 **That it might be fulfilled** which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

11. A BLIND SPIRIT:

Some “Demon Possessed” people have poor eyesight and their eyes are often cloudy.

A “Blind spirit” usually causes this and it needs to be ‘cast out’.

Many times people’s eyes have cleared up when we have done a deliverance, even when we have not called out a “Blind spirit”. In some foreign countries, we have even seen some totally ‘blind’ people that were ‘Possessed’ with a “Blind spirit” gain their eyesight after God delivered them.

A “Blind spirit” can also cause a person to be ‘blind’ in their heart to the things of God.

(Ephesians 4:18) Once they are delivered from this “Demon”, and Saved through the Sinner’s prayer, they will begin to understand the things of God for the first time.

Matt 12:22

22 **Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind**, and dumb: and **he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.**

Luke 7:21

21 **And in that same hour he cured many of their infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many that were blind he gave sight.**

Luke 4:18

18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, **and recovering of sight to the blind**, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

John 10:21

21 Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a devil. **Can a devil open the eyes of the blind?**

12. THE SPIRIT OF ANTI-CHRIST:

The “spirit of Anti-Christ” is a difficult “Demon” to deliver. This is because most people that have the “spirit of Anti-Christ”, do not believe they have this “Demon”. These people will say they believe in Jesus, but they do not have Jesus **in** their hearts, and they do not understand the difference. (Romans 10:9-10)

Remember, even the ‘devils’ believe. (James 2:19)

It is better not to say anything to the person with this “Demon” during a deliverance, just ‘cast out’ the “spirit of Anti-Christ” in Jesus Name, and send it to the ‘Pit’.

Notice in (1 John 4:2) that it is the ‘spirit’ that must confess that ‘Jesus Christ came in the flesh’. If a person is Saved, the Holy Spirit within us will easily lead us to say this, but if a person has the “spirit of Anti-Christ in them, they will not be able to say that ‘Jesus Christ came in the flesh’. (1 John 4:13)

After you have ‘called out’ the “spirit of Anti-Christ” during a deliverance, have the person say that ‘Jesus Christ came in the flesh’. If he/she can’t say it, or if their eyes keep blinking, start all over again and continue to ‘cast out’ the ‘spirit of Anti-Christ’. Don’t worry if you have to repeat praying and continuing the deliverance; remember, even Jesus prayed twice for the healing of the blind man. (Mark 8:25)

I Jn 2:18-19

18 Little children, it is the last time: and **as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists**; whereby we know that it is the last time.

19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.

I Jn 2:22

22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? **He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.**

I Jn 4:3

3 **And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist**, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

II Jn 1:7

7 **For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.**

13. THE SPIRIT OF ERROR:

Although most people ‘error’ through the ‘Works of the Flesh’, there is a “spirit of Error”. (Galatians 5:19-21)

The way you identify those that have this “Demon”, is through their excess compassion and desires for the ‘things’ of this world. They identify with the world, and they greatly enjoy deceiving others into wanting the ‘things’ of the world.

As Christians, we have the “Spirit of Truth” within us, and these deceivers should not fool us.

Unfortunately, there are those with the “spirit of error” within today’s Christian Leadership. They are leading the ‘foolish’ Christians back into the things of the world from which they came. This is because they are not listening to, nor are they sensitive to, God the Holy Spirit, who is the “Spirit of Truth”! (John 14:16-17 15:26 16:13)

This “spirit of Error” is not difficult to ‘cast out’, and as with all deliverances, once the person has been delivered, he/she should then be “Baptized with the Holy Ghost”. This however should only be done by the leading of the Lord. (Acts 11:16))

I Jn 4:5-6

5 **They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world,** and the world heareth them.

6 **We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us;** he that is not of God heareth not us. **Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.**

Prov 14:22

22 **Do they not err that devise evil?** but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.

Isa 29:24

24 **They also that erred in spirit** shall come to understanding, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine.

Isa 32:6

6 **For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work iniquity, to practise hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD,** to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail.

1 Tim 6:10

10 **For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith,** and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

1 Tim 6:20-21

20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, **avoiding profane and vain babblings,** and oppositions of science falsely so called:

21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. ...

2 Pet 2:18

18 For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error.

James 5:20

20 Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

2 Pet 3:17

17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness.

14. A LYING SPIRIT:

A "Lying spirit", is the "Demon" that may be the cause of someone's 'habitual lying', particularly in young people. If you have tried all types of discipline for your children because of 'lying' and it has failed; try doing a deliverance. Follow the procedures as outlined in this "Study Guide", and 'cast out' the "Lying spirit".

IKing 22:22-23 2 Chr 18:21-22

22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.

Ps 52:3

3 Thou lovest evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah.

Ps 59:12

12 For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips let them even be taken in their pride: and for cursing and lying which they speak.

Ps 119:163

163 I hate and abhor lying: but thy law do I love.

Ps 120:2

2 Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips, and from a deceitful tongue.

Prov 6:16-17

16 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:

17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

Prov 12:22

22 **Lying lips are abomination to the LORD:** but they that deal truly are his delight.

VI. UNBELIEF:

“Unbelief”, can be the cause of failure in a deliverance.

The most important ‘Gift’ we need to have in ‘casting out’ “Demons” is the ‘Charisma Gift’ of ‘**Faith**’. It is ‘**Faith**’ that will help us to ‘**believe**’ that we can do it.

(1 Corinthians 12:9)

Someone needs to have the ‘**Faith**’ to ‘**Believe**’ in a deliverance for it to be successful. It can be the person doing the deliverance, the one that has brought the “Demon Possessed” person, and/or the person themselves. If ‘All’ ‘**Believe**’, the better the success rate!

When The Father of a son who had a ‘Dumb spirit’ asked Jesus to cast out the “Demon” after the disciples had failed, Jesus said the following:

Mark 9:23-24

23 Jesus said unto him, **If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.**

24 **And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.**

The following is the meaning of ‘**Belief**’ and “**Unbelief**” in these two Scriptures:

4100 pisteuo (pist-yoo'-o);

from 4102; **to have faith** (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), i.e. credit; by implication, to entrust (especially one's spiritual well-being to Christ):

KJV-- **believe** (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

570 apaistia (ap-is-tee'-ah);

from 571; **faithlessness**, i.e. (negatively) disbelief (lack of Christian faith), or (positively) unfaithfulness (disobedience):

KJV-- **unbelief.**

When reading this story in Matthew, emphasis has usually been on ‘Prayer and Fasting’. It is true that ‘Unclean spirits’ and ‘Dumb and Deaf spirits’, do come out only by ‘Prayer and Fasting’. (Mark 9:25, 29 Luke 9:40, 42)

However, the main reason the disciples could not cast out the “Demon” is because of their “**Unbelief**”.

Matt 17:14-21

14 And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying,

- 15 **Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed:** for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.
- 16 **And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him.**
- 17 **Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation,** how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me.
- 18 **And Jesus rebuked the devil;** and he departed out of him: **and the child was cured from that very hour.**
- 19 **Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?**
- 20 **And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief:** for verily I say unto you, **If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed,** ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and **nothing shall be impossible unto you.**
- 21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

VII. SEDUCING SPIRITS:

On the way to a Drug Rehabilitation Ranch, where the Timothy II Team was doing many deliverances, the Lord spoke to Timothy II. He said that when we were doing a deliverance and the person was acting “Demonic”, but we saw no signs of “Demon Possession” in the person’s eyes, then that person may have “Seducing spirits”.

He said, if they do, then they needed to be ‘Loosed’ from them.

This is because “Seducing spirits” do not ‘Possess’ a person; they merely ‘attach’ themselves to them and “Seduce their minds”.

The results however, can be just as devastating as if they were ‘Possessed’.

“Seducing spirits” can ruin people’s lives, including Christians.

If allowed to continue, the person could eventually ‘depart’ from the Faith.

When praying for people who have “Seducing spirits”, you won’t see “Demons” in their eyes, but the “Holy Spirit” will reveal to you if they have “Seducing spirits”.

This is what is usually the case, when a Christian acts like he/she has “Demons”, but there is nothing there.

“Seducing spirits” are easily removed, if the person wants to get rid of them. The problem is that some Christians don’t think they have them, and ‘Pride’ keeps them from getting ‘Loosed’.

To ‘Loosen’ a person with “Seducing spirits”, just say: **“I command you “Seducing spirits” to let ‘loose’ of this person, in Jesus’ Name”.** They will leave immediately!

1 Tim 4:1

1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that **in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;**

Luke 13:12

12 And when **Jesus** saw her, he called her to him, and **said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.**

VIII. GENERATIONAL CURSES:

“Generational Curses”, do not always involve “Demons”. However, we have found through experience, that many who are “Demon Possessed”, do have “Generational Curses”. This is just something the “Holy Spirit” has taught us over the years. Many people have been crying out for years for help in this area, but no one knew what to do.

Here is what you do:

As the “Holy Spirit” leads, look in the person’s eyes and say something like this: **“I break you “Generational Curses” in Jesus’ Name, and never to return.”**

As with the deliverance of “Demons”, the person will become somewhat bewildered.

This is because all of a sudden, they will no longer have confusion and strife in their life, and their burdens have been lifted. Next, lead them in the ‘Sinner’s Prayer’.

After this experience, they will probably need to rest. Many sleep great for the first time in many years. (Psalms 4:8 Proverbs 3:24)

The following Scriptures confirm that “Generational Curses” are real:

Exod 20:3 Deut 5:7

3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Exod 20:5 Deut 5:9

5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: **for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;**

Exod 34:7

7 Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, **and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.**

Num 14:18

18 The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, **and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation.**

Num 14:33

33 **And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcasses be wasted in the wilderness. (Four Generations)**

Deut 23:2

2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD.

Even though “Generational Curses” may cause the faults or problems of the Fathers up to the third and fourth Generation, they are **not** the cause of our own physical or spiritual death. That is caused by our own individual Sin!

Deut 24:16

16 The fathers shall not be put to death for the children, neither shall the children be put to death for the fathers: every man shall be put to death for his own sin.

Ezek 18:20

20 The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.

The ‘good news’ for us Christians is that once we are ‘Truly’ Saved, the chain of any “Generational Curses” is broken. We have found however that those that have “Generational Curses” and are the first Generation to get Saved, may still need to ‘break them’, including their children that are already born. This is because this cloud that has been over them for so long needs to be lifted much like the loosening of “Seducing spirits” from Christians.

Ps 112:1-2

1 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

2 His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed

Luke 1:50

50 And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.

1 Pet 2:9

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

IX. EXORCISM VS DELIVERANCE:

The term “Exorcists” is used only once in the Bible. “Exorcists” were wandering or vagabond Jews that performed “Exorcisms” by an oath, by a spell, or by conjuring up. These “Exorcists” were ‘Unsaved’ and **not** ‘believers’. This is why I do not like to use the term “Exorcism” for a deliverance; it is not Scriptural.

It is also why I believe the only harm that “Demons” can do physically to anyone during a deliverance, is if they are ‘Unbelievers’! This is the reason why some Religious Leaders have been attacked physically during an “Exorcism. They are **not** Saved! (Luke 10:19 Psalms 50:16-17)

The following is the meaning of the word “Exorcist” in the Greek:

1845 exorkistes (ex-or-kis-tace’);

from 1844; **one that binds by an oath (or spell), i.e. (by implication) an "exorcist" (conjurer):**

KJV-- **exorcist.**

(Strong’s Concordance)

EXORCIST

exorkistes ^1845^ denotes (a) "one who administers an oath"; (b) "an exorcist" (akin to exorkizo, "to adjure," from orkos, "an oath"), "one who employs a formula of conjuration for the expulsion of demons," <Acts 19:13>. The practice of "exorcism" was carried on by strolling Jews, who used their power in the recitation of particular names.#

(Vine's Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words)

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The following Scriptures verify that ‘Unbelievers’ should never attempt to do a deliverance. If they do attempt it, it will not work because they do not know Jesus. They do not have any ‘authority’ over the “Demons”, and therefore they may get beat-up by the “Demons” themselves!

Such was the case with the seven sons of Sceva that attempted an “Exorcism”, and the “Evil spirit” prevailed against them.

Acts 19:13-16

13 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.

14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so.

15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?

16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

It is interesting to note, that the “Demon” not only knew Jesus, but also Paul!

This means that “Demons” recognize ‘Believers’ as belonging to Jesus, and that is why they **must** obey our commands! (James 4:7)

It is also interesting that the “Demon” said to the sons of Sceva: “who are you?” This means they do not recognize ‘Unbelievers’, even if they use the Name of Jesus! Amen!

CONCLUSION:

IN CONCLUSION, REMEMBER:

- No “Demon” can ‘Possess’ a Christian, but Christians can be “Seduced” by “Demons”. Therefore, Christians need to be ‘Loosed’ if they have ‘Seducing spirits’.
- No matter who the person is, or how long they say they have been Saved, if a person has been delivered from “Demon Possession”, lead them in the ‘Sinner’s Prayer’.
- If they are ‘Seduced’ by “Demons”, this isn’t necessary.
- If you are not sure what to do, what does it hurt to repeat the ‘Sinner’s Prayer’ just to make sure? Amen?
- “Demons” cannot harm a ‘child of God’ physically, although they may threaten to do so. We do not need to be afraid of them, however, we do need to be alert!
- Only allow people to do a deliverance with you who are ‘Mature’ Christians that are “Filled” with the Holy Ghost.
- Everyone should ‘Fast and Pray’, including the person being delivered, whenever possible, before doing a deliverance!
- For clarity, when in another country, use an interpreter to speak ‘along with you’ to the person before, during and after the deliverance.
- You may want the interpreter to help ‘cast out’ the “Demons” along with you. We have found even “Demons” sometimes cause language barriers.

ALSO REMEMBER THAT:

Matt 12:28

28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Mark 16:17

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Luke 10:17

17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

JESUS SAID:

Luke 10:20

20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
