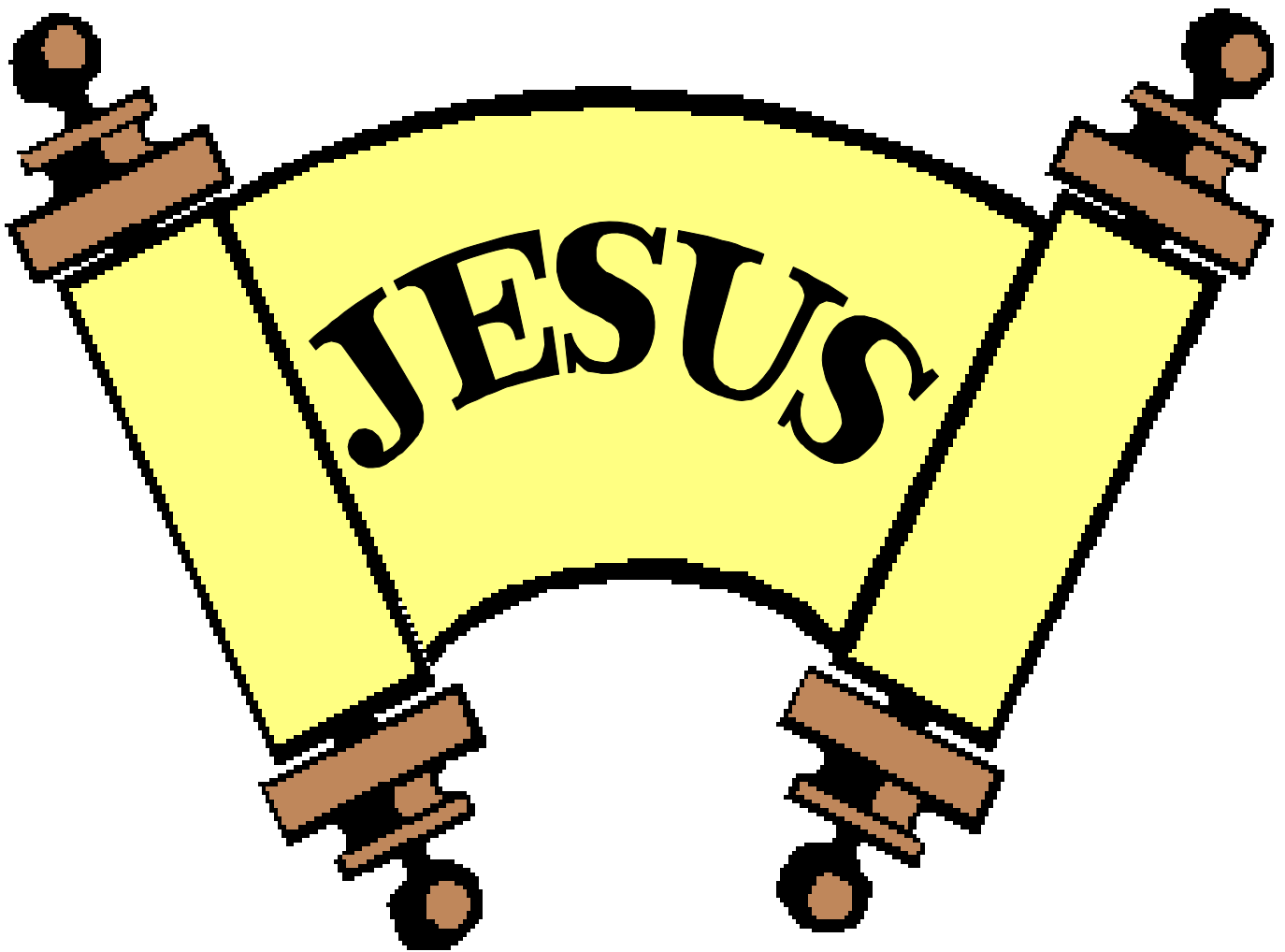

INTRODUCTION:

There are many famous names in the Bible, such as the Prophets in the Old Testament, and the Disciples in the New Testament.

Mary & Joseph the mother and father of Jesus, are mentioned throughout the world.

We have many famous church denominational names such as Baptist, Methodist, Catholic, Presbyterian, etc.

There are “Inter-Faith” groups made up of different religions that are meeting worldwide. But none of these names mean anything.

The name Timothy II may be unusual, but it will get you nothing!

BECAUSE OF JESUS.....

1. HIS NAME IS HOLY:

Ps 111:9

9 He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant forever:
Holy and Reverend is his Name.

2. HIS NAME IS ABOVE EVERY NAME:

Phil 2:9

9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a Name which is above every Name:

3. AT HIS NAME EVERY KNEE SHALL BOW:

Phil 2:10

10 That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

4. AT HIS NAME EVERY TONGUE SHALL CONFESS JESUS IS LORD:

Phil 2:11

11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

5. FOR THERE IS NO OTHER NAME:

Acts 4:12 (Peter & John)

12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other Name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

6. FOR SALVATION:

Rom 10:13 (Paul)

13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

7. THAT REPENTANCE & FORGIVENESS OF SINS ARE TO BE PREACHED IN HIS NAME:

Luke 24:47 (Jesus)

47 **And that Repentance and Remission (Cancelled or annulled) of sins should be preached in his Name among all Nations, beginning at Jerusalem.**

8. THAT THROUGH HIS NAME, WHOEVER BELIEVES AND REPENTS, WILL RECEIVE FORGIVENESS OF SINS:

Acts 10:43 (Peter)

43 **To him give all the prophets witness, that through his Name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.**

Acts 2:38

38 **Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.**

9. AND WHOEVER IS BAPTIZED IN HIS NAME WILL RECEIVE THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:

Acts 19:5-6 (Disciples at Ephesus)

5 **When they heard this, they were Baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus.**

6 **And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.**

10. THERE IS HEALING IN HIS NAME:

Acts 3:16 (Peter heals the lame man)

16 **And His Name through faith in his Name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by Him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.**

James 5:14

14 **Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with Oil in the Name of the Lord:**

11. WE HAVE THE POWER TO CAST OUT DEVILS IN HIS NAME:

Mark 16:17 (Jesus)

17 **And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;**

Acts 16:18 (Girl with spirit of divination)

18 **And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the Name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.**

12. SIGNS & WONDERS ARE DONE BY HIS NAME:

Acts 4:30 (Peter - the place is shaken - all filled with the Holy Ghost)

30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; **and that Signs and Wonders may be done By the Name of thy Holy Child Jesus.**

13. ASK THE FATHER IN HIS NAME:

John 15:16 (Jesus said this - if we keep His commandments & bear fruit)

16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: **that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My Name, he may give it you.**

14. GOD COMMANDS US TO BELIEVE ON THE NAME OF HIS SON:

I Jn 3:23 (Not a suggestion - then we will receive what we ask)

23 **And this is His commandment, That we should believe on the Name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.**

15. THE CHURCH AT PHILADELPHIA IS OUR EXAMPLE:

Rev 3:7-8

7 **And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia** write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

8 **I know thy works:** behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, **and hast not denied My Name.**

CONCLUSION:**THOSE OF US THAT NAME THE NAME OF JESUS:****1. MUST DEPART FROM ALL WICKEDNESS:**

2 Tim 2:19

19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, **Let every one that Nameth the Name of Christ depart from iniquity.**

2. FOR:

Eph 2:18

18 **For through Him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.**

3. AND WE MUST DO EVERYTHING IN HIS NAME:

Col 3:17

17 **And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do All in the Name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by Him.**

4. BECAUSE:**Ps 72:17-19** (David)

17 **His Name shall endure for ever: his Name shall be continued as long as the sun:** and men shall be blessed in Him: all Nations shall call him blessed.

18 Blessed be the Lord God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things.

19 **And blessed be his glorious Name for ever:** and let the whole earth be filled with his glory; **Amen, and Amen.**
