

# SIGNS & WONDERS

## INTRODUCTION:

The Holy Spirit has led Timothy II to write this “Study Guide” because of the ‘False Doctrine’ that is prevalent in the church, that states that “Signs & Wonders”, much like the ‘Charisma’ Gifts of the Holy Spirit, are not for today.

“Sign & Wonders” *are* for today and are being seen by many in the “Body of Christ” throughout the world.

Many ‘Believers’ are experiencing them themselves; such as casting out devils, laying hands on the sick, etc. (Mark 16:17)

The Timothy II Team has been involved in them during our Missionary trips to the Philippines and other countries, especially the casting out of demons.

“Signs & Wonders” are not the ‘Charisma’ Gifts of the Holy Spirit, but may overlap them, especially ‘Miracles’.

There are also “Signs & Wonders” that God is doing sovereignly. (Luke 21:11)

In these last days, it is going to take these “Signs and Wonders” to help draw the unbelievers to Jesus.

Today the street person, the gang members, etc., are much harder people than those in the past. (2 Timothy 3:1-7) Violent crime is at an all time high.

These hard-core people, plus all of the other people in the world, because of the access and excess of the media, have heard nothing but talk, talk, talk, talk, talk.

This has hardened people to hearing messages. They want to see something that will prove that what you say is true.

It is going to take something of the ‘supernatural’ that they have not seen to cause these hardened people to believe. (Acts 8:6)

The Devil being a liar, must have something to imitate, therefore, in order to produce ‘lying signs & wonders’ (Matthew 24:24 2 Thessalonians 2:9), he must wait for the real to become evident. As yet there is little for him to imitate.

This is why I believe that ‘True’ “Signs & Wonders” are on the increase, and that we will soon be visited by God in even a more powerful way than ever before.

It really bothers me when so-called Bible scholars, who are not ‘Filled with the Holy Ghost’, make comments like this.....

"Signs" confirmatory of what God had accomplished in the atoning sacrifice of Christ, His resurrection and ascension, and of the sending of the Holy Spirit, were given to the Jews for their recognition, as at Pentecost, and supernatural acts by apostolic ministry, as well as by the supernatural operations in the churches, such as the gift of tongues and prophesyings; **there is no record of the continuance of these latter after the circumstances recorded in (Acts 19:1-20).**

## **I. WHAT ARE SIGNS & WONDERS?**

### **SIGNS:**

#### **The dictionary says:**

That by which anything is known or represented. A symbol, a token, an omen, a signal an indication. A gesture used instead of speech.  
To mark with a sign, especially with the sign of the cross.

#### **The Bible says in the Greek:**

**SIGN** 1. **semeion** ^4592^, "a sign, mark, indication, token," is used (a) of that which distinguished a person or thing from others, (b) of a "sign" as a warning or admonition, (c) of miraculous acts (1) as tokens of divine authority and power.

### **WONDERS:**

#### **The Dictionary says:**

Astonishment; a marvel, miracle. Wonders are natural, miracles are supernatural. The whole creation is full of wonders. The Bible contains an account of the miracles. Wonders are real. Marvels are often fictitious.

To be astonished at; to feel surprise and amazement;

To think or speculate curiously and sometimes doubtfully . To be filled with awe; marvel.

A remarkable or extraordinary phenomenon, deed or event, marvel or miracle.

#### **The Bible says in the Greek:**

#### **WONDER (NOUN AND VERB)**

1. **teras** ^5059^, "something strange," causing the beholder to marvel, is always used in the plural, always rendered "wonders," and generally follows semeia, "signs"; A sign is intended to appeal to the understanding, a "wonder" appeals to the imagination, a power (dunamis) indicates its source as supernatural. "Wonders" are manifested as divine operations in thirteen occurrences (9 times in Acts); three times they are ascribed to the work of Satan through human agents.

## **SIGN**

Something that points to, or represents, something larger or more important than itself. The word is used in this way to refer to a wide variety of things in the Bible. But by far the most important use of the word is in reference to the acts of God. Thus, it is often linked with "wonders." In the Old Testament most references point to the miracles produced by God to help deliver the Hebrew people from slavery in Egypt.

In the New Testament the word signs is linked with both "wonders" and "miracles". Signs point primarily to the powerful, saving activity of God as experienced through the ministry of Jesus and the apostles. The word occurs frequently in the Gospel of John, pointing to the deeper, symbolic meaning of the miracles performed by Jesus. Throughout the Bible the true significance of a sign is understood only through faith.

## **II. HOW SIGNS & WONDERS WORK THROUGH THE BELIEVER:**

When the Holy Spirit comes upon us, we are turned into another person. When this happens, we just do what we are led to do by the Holy Spirit; no matter how odd it seems to us.

### **1 Sam 10:1**

1 Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured it upon his head, and kissed him, and said, Is it not because the LORD hath anointed thee to be captain over his inheritance?

### **1 Sam 10:6-7**

6 **And the Spirit of the LORD will come upon thee, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be turned into another man.**

7 **And let it be, when these signs are come unto thee, that thou do as occasion serve thee; for God is with thee.**

## **III. THE RESULTS**

“Signs” will follow the preaching of the Word.

**Mark 16:17-18**

17 **And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;**

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; **they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**

**Mark 16:20**

20 **And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.** Amen.

**IV. SIGNS AND WONDERS IN ACTION:****BY GOD:**

Job speaking about God said:

**Job 9:10**

10 **Which doeth great things** past finding out; yea, **and wonders without number.**

The Psalm of Asaph.

**Ps 77:14**

14 **Thou art the God that doest wonders:** thou hast declared thy strength among the people.

King Darius wrote the following to all nations, after Daniel was delivered by God from the lion's den.

**Dan 6:25-27**

25 **Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages,** that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.

26 I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before **the God of Daniel: for he is the living God,** and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end.

27 He delivereth and rescueth, and **he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth,** who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.

Peter speaking at Pentecost.

**Acts 2:17**

17 **And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God,** I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

**Acts 2:19**

19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

**BY JESUS:**

“Signs & Wonders” done by Jesus.

**Acts 10:38**

38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

**Acts 2:22**

22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

**Matt 15:29-31**

29 And Jesus departed from thence, and came nigh unto the sea of Galilee; and went up into a mountain, and sat down there.

30 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them:

31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

**John 20:30-31**

30 And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book:

31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

**BY THE APOSTLES:**

The ‘Sign’ of an Apostle is “Signs & Wonders” and Mighty Deeds (Dunamis, Dunamis).

**2 Cor 12:12**

12 Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

**Acts 2:42-43**

42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

## **V. HOW SIGNS AND WONDERS ARE DONE:**

### **BY HIS WILL:**

“Signs & Wonders” are done by the Will of God.

Ananias spoke this to Paul after his experience on the road to Damascus.

#### **Acts 22:12**

12 And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt there,

#### **Acts 22:14-15**

14 And he said, **The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest know his will**, and see that Just One, and shouldest hear the voice of his mouth.

15 For thou shalt be his witness unto all men of what thou hast seen and heard.

#### **Heb 2:4**

4 **God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles**, and gifts (Merismos or Distributions) of the Holy Ghost, **according to his own will?**

And we can know His Will!

#### **Rom 12:1-2**

1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, **that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.**

### **BY HIS POWER:**

We can receive the ‘Power’ to do “Signs & Wonders” by being ‘Filled’ or ‘Baptized with the Holy Ghost’.

That ‘Power’ will cause us to ‘Go out’ and become ‘witnesses’ for Jesus, in our city, in our state, our country, and throughout the world.

#### **Acts 1:8**

8 **But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.**

This ‘Notable Miracle’ was not done by the ‘Power of the Apostles’, but by the ‘Power of God’.

**Acts 4:16**

16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? **for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them** is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it.

**Acts 3:11-12**

11 And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, **all the people** ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, **greatly wondering.**

12 And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, **why marvel ye at this?** or why look ye so earnestly on us, **as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?**

**Acts 4:33**

33 **And with great power gave the apostles witness** of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Stephen (who was a Deacon) was full of 'Power' and did 'Great Wonders' and 'Miracles'.

**Acts 6:8**

8 **And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.**

Paul said he 'Fully' preached the Gospel and made the Gentiles obedient, through 'Mighty' "Signs & Wonders".

**Rom 15:18-19**

18 For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought by me, **to make the Gentiles obedient, by word and deed,**

19 **Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God;** so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum (Macedonia or Bosnia), **I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.**

**BY HIS NAME:**

A 'Notable Miracle' is done in the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

**Acts 3:1-2**

1 Now **Peter and John** went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.

2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

**Acts 3:6-7**

6 **Then Peter said,** Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: **In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.**

7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: **and immediately his feet and ancle bones received strength.**

**Acts 3:10**

10 And they knew that it was he which sat for alms at the Beautiful gate of the temple: **and they were filled with wonder and amazement** at that which had happened unto him.

**Acts 3:16**

16 **And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong**, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

Peter and John's Company prayed for "Signs & Wonders" to be done in the Name of the Holy Child Jesus.

**Acts 4:23-24**

23 And being let go, **they went to their own company**, and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said unto them.

24 And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:

**Acts 4:29-32**

29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and **grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word**,

30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and **that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus**.

31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

Peter heals Aeneas who had palsy and was confined to a bed for eight years, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

**Acts 9:32-35**

32 And it came to pass, as Peter passed throughout all quarters, he came down also to the saints which dwelt at Lydda.

33 And there **he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy**.

34 And **Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole**: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately.

35 And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

Paul casts out a 'spirit of divination' out of a young girl, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

**Acts 16:16-18**

16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, **a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination** met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying (Foretelling the future):

17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried (mocking), saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

18 **And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.** And he came out the same hour. (Mark 16:17)

Even evil spirits know whether a person casting out demons in the Name of Jesus is Saved or not. If not, it won't work. I want the Demons to know who Timothy II is - do you?

**Acts 19:13-17**

13 Then **certain** of the vagabond Jews, **exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.**

14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so.

15 **And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?**

16 **And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them,** and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, **and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.**

**BY THE HANDS:**

The Apostles did many "Signs & Wonders" by their hands.

**Acts 5:12**

12 **And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people;** (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.

Peter and John's Company prayed.

**Acts 4:30**

30 **By stretching forth thine hand to heal;** and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

Paul and Barnabas did "Signs & Wonders" by their hands in Iconium.

**Acts 14:1**

1 And it came to pass in Iconium, that they went both together into the synagogue of the Jews, and so spake, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks believed.

**Acts 14:3**

3 **Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.**

God wrought 'Special Miracles' by the Hands of Paul.

**Acts 19:11-12**

11 And **God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:**

12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

Paul layed his Hands on him, and healed the father of Publius, who was the Chief of the Island of Malta.

**Acts 28:7-9**

7 In the same quarters were possessions of the chief man of the island, whose name was Publius; who received us, and lodged us three days courteously.

8 And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom **Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him.**

9 So when this was done, others also, which had diseases in the island, came, and were healed:

**VI. SIGNS & WONDERS IN GENERAL:**

Believers brought the sick to Peter, just so his shadow would touch them so that they would be healed. Much like the woman that touched the hem of Jesus' garment. Then came a multitude of people with the sick and demon possessed, and they were all healed.

**Acts 5:14-16**

14 **And believers** were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

15 Insomuch that they **brought forth the sick into the streets**, and laid them on beds and couches, **that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.**

16 **There came also a multitude** out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, **bringing sick folks**, and them which were vexed (troubled) with unclean spirits: **and they were healed every one.**

Philip the Evangelist, who was a Deacon in the church, preached Christ, and then there followed Miracles, “Signs & Wonders”.

**Acts 8:5-7**

5 **Then Philip** went down to the city of Samaria, and **preached Christ** unto them.  
 6 **And the people** with one accord **gave heed** unto those things which Philip spake, **hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.**  
 7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

**Acts 8:13**

13 **Then Simon** himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and **wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.**

Peter ‘raises’ the dead woman, Tabitha.

**Acts 9:36-42**

36 Now there was at Joppa **a certain disciple named Tabitha**, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did.  
 37 And it came to pass in those days, that **she was sick, and died:** whom when they had washed, they laid her in an upper chamber.  
 38 And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh to Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring him that he would not delay to come to them.  
 39 Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and shewing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them.  
 40 **But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.**  
 41 **And he gave her his hand,** and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, **presented her alive.**  
 42 And it was known throughout all Joppa; and many believed in the Lord.

Paul calls down ‘blindness’ on Elymas the sorcerer (Bar-jesus).

**Acts 13:6-12**

6 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was **Bar-jesus:**  
 7 Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God.  
 8 **But Elymas the sorcerer** (for so is his name by interpretation) **withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith.**  
 9 **Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,**

10 **And said,** O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

11 **And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season.** And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.

12 **Then the deputy,** when he saw what was done, **believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.**

Paul 'heals' a cripple from birth.

#### **Acts 14:8-10**

8 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being **a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:**

9 The same heard **Paul** speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and **perceiving that he had faith to be healed,**

10 **Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.**

Barnabas and Paul share what God had done through them in "Signs & Wonders" and 'Miracles' among the Gentiles.

#### **Acts 15:4**

4 And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and of the apostles and elders, and **they declared all things that God had done with them.**

#### **Acts 15:12**

12 Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to **Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.**

God wrought 'Special Miracles' by the hands of Paul.

We too have been involved in some of these Miracles, however, they can only be done through the leading of the Holy Spirit, and these items cannot be sold for filthy lucre!

#### **Acts 19:11-12**

11 **And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:**

12 **So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.**

### **VII. FALSE SIGNS & WONDERS:**

All "Signs & Wonders", must draw us to the True and Living God through Jesus Christ, or they are 'false signs & wonders'.

**Deut 13:1-5**

1 **If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder,**

2 **And the sign or the wonder come to pass,** whereof he spake unto thee, **saying, Let us go after other gods,** which thou hast not known, and let us serve them;

3 **Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams:** for the LORD your **God proveth you,** to know **whether ye love the LORD your God** with all your heart and with all your soul.

4 Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him.

5 **And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death;** because he hath spoken to turn you away from the LORD your **God, which** brought you out of the land of Egypt, and **redeemed you out of the house of bondage,** to thrust thee out of the way which the LORD thy God commanded thee to walk in. **So shalt thou put the evil away from the midst of thee.**

False Christs, and False Prophets will rise up more and more and will show 'great signs & wonders'. This will continue through the Tribulation Period. This is to imitate what the True "Body of Christ" has done; so that they can deceive the elect (the Jews and Tribulation Saints) if it were possible.

**Matt 24:21-24** (Mark 13:19-22)

21 **For then shall be great tribulation,** such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: **but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.**

23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.

24 **For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.**

The Anti-Christ will come after the working of Satan's 'signs & lying wonders'.

**II Th 2:7-9**

7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.

8 **And then shall that Wicked be revealed,** whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

9 Even him, whose coming is **after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,**

## **CONCLUSION:**

King Nebuchadnezzar wrote after Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were delivered out of the fiery furnace:

### **Dan 3:28**
