


GOD'S



PSYCHOLOGY

INTRODUCTION:

“God’s Psychology” differs from that of man’s psychology, because man cannot understand the things of God. This is because God is a Spirit, and only those who are born again and have the Holy Spirit in them can understand Him. (John 3:3, 6)

1 Cor 2:6-7

6 Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect (complete): yet not the wisdom of this world,...

7 **But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom,** which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

1 Cor 2:9-16

9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for **the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.**

11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so **the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.**

12 **Now we have received,** not the spirit of the world, but **the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.**

13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but **which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.**

14 But **the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God:** for they are foolishness unto him: **neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.**

15 But he that is spiritual judgeth (understands) all things, yet he himself is judged (understood) of no man.

16 **For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.**

When we become Christians, we begin a new life, and we don’t have to keep regurgitating the old one!

2 Cor 5:17

17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: **old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.**

Rom 6:4

4 ...even so **we also should walk in newness of life.**

Rom 6:6

6 **Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him,...**

As Christians, we become transformed by the renewing of our minds:

Rom 12:2

2 And be not conformed to this world: but **be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind,** that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Eph 4:23-24

23 And **be renewed in the spirit of your mind;**

24 **And that ye put on the new man,** which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

And our inner man is renewed daily:

Eph 3:16

16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be **strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;**

2 Cor 4:16

16 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, **yet the inward man is renewed day by day.**

We have the Comforter, so we don't need man to comfort us:

John 14:16-17

16 And I will pray **the Father**, and he **shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;**

17 **Even the Spirit of truth;** whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye **know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.**

John 14:26

26 But **the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost**, whom the Father will send in my name, **he shall teach you all things,...**

God has given us Peace and we need not be anxious nor have any doubts or fears.

John 14:27

27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. **Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.**

2 Tim 1:7

7 **For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

Phil 4:6-7

6 **Be careful (Anxious) for nothing;** but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

7 And **the peace of God**, which passeth all understanding, **shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.**

CONCLUSION:

Finally my brethren, because God loves us, we know that we can cast all of our cares on Him!

1 Pet 5:7

7 **Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.**

1 Jn 4:10

10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

1 Jn 4:16

16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. **God is love;** and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.

1 Jn 4:18

18 **There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.**

Heb 4:15-16

15 **For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities;** but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

16 **Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.**
