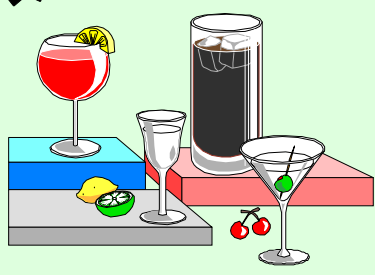
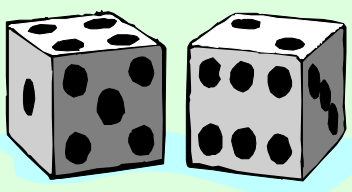
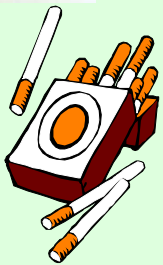




SIN



WHAT IS SIN?

“Sin” is the transgression of God’s Laws. “Sin” is also the missing of the mark, which is not finding Salvation through Jesus Christ, who died for our “Sins”. That is the ultimate transgression that leads to Spiritual Death and Hell!

The Dictionary says: Offense against the laws of God; wickedness; to transgress, do wrong.

In the Greek: To miss the mark so as not to share in the prize; trespass, offend.

1 Jn 3:4

4 **Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.**

COMMENTARY:

“Sin” came into the world by Adam and Eve, causing all of us to become “Sinners”.

WE HAVE ALL SINNED:

Rom 5:12

12 **Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world,** and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, **for that all have sinned:**

Rom 3:23

23 **For all have sinned,** and come short of the glory of God;

1 Jn 1:8

8 **If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves,** and the truth is not in us.

VARIOUS TYPES OF SIN:

There are many types of “Sin” expressed in the Bible. The following are some of these:

1 Sam 15:23

23 **For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft,** and **stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry.** Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD,

Ps 59:12

12 For the **sin** of their **mouth** and the **words** of their **lips** let them even be taken in their **pride:** and for **cursing** and **lying** which they speak.

Prov 21:4

4 An **high look,** and a **proud heart,** and the **plowing** (lamp) of the wicked, **is sin.**

Prov 24:9

9 **The thought of foolishness is sin:**

Rom 14:23

23 ...for **whatsoever is not of faith is sin.**

1 Cor 6:18

18 Flee **fornication.** Every **sin** that a man doeth is without the body; but **he that committeth fornication sinneth** against his own body.

2 Cor 12:21

21 ...and that I shall bewail many which have **sinned** already, **and have not repented** of the **uncleanness** and **fornication** and **lasciviousness** (lewdness) which they have committed.

Titus 3:10-11

10 **A man that is an heretick** after the first and second admonition reject;

11 Knowing that he that is such **is subverted, and sinneth,**...

James 2:9

9 **But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin,** and are convinced of the law **as transgressors.**

James 4:17

17 ...to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

I Jn 5:17

17 All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.

THE RESULTS OF SIN:

The results of "Sin" is bondage and eventually death!

John 8:34

34 Jesus answered them, **Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.**

Rom 6:16

16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Rom 6:23

23 **For the wages of sin is death;** but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

WARNING TO BELIEVERS:

Even as Believers, if we "Sin" Willfully (willingly), it can lead to Presumptuous (arrogant) "Sin", and we could 'Fall Away' permanently. (Luke 8:13 Heb 6:6)

Heb 10:26

26 **For if we sin wilfully** after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, **there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,**

Ps 19:13

13 **Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins;** let them not have dominion over me: **then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.**

Rom 6:6-7

6 **Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.**

7 **For he that is dead is freed from sin.**

Rom 6:12

12 **Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body,** that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.

1 Cor 15:34

34 **Awake to righteousness, and sin not;** for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.

Gal 2:17-18

17 **But if,** while we seek to be justified by Christ, **we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.**

18 **For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.**

I Jn 3:6

6 **Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him.**

I Jn 3:8-9

8 **He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning.** For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

9 **Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin;** for his seed remaineth in him: **and he cannot sin,** because he is born of God.

THEREFORE DON'T BE A WIMP:

Heb 12:4

4 **Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.**

THE ANSWER TO SIN:

Because Jesus was made to be “Sin” for us, and we have Jesus in our hearts; “Sin” does not have dominion over us and we are ‘free’ from “Sin”!

Acts 4:12

12 **Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.**

Rom 6:14

14 **For sin shall not have dominion over you:** for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

Rom 6:22

22 **But now being made free from sin,** and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, **and the end everlasting life.**

2 Cor 5:21

21 **For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin;** that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

I Jn 3:5

5 **And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins;** and in him is no sin.

CONCLUSION:

The ‘Good News’ for Christians is that if we commit a “Sin”, and we ‘Confess it’ and ‘Repent’ immediately, Jesus is Faithful and Just to forgive us of that “Sin”!

Acts 3:19

19 **Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out,** when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

I Jn 1:7

7 **But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.**

Col 1:14

14 **In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:**

I Jn 1:9

9 **If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins,** and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

I Jn 4:10

10 **Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.**

Luke 15:7

7 **I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth,** more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.
