

CONCLUSION:

Because of our Christian Love, it is important not to ignore The Scorner. By showing them our Love and through prayer we should try to get them to repent and to turn from their ways. If they will not, then they need to be dealt with whether in the Home, the Church or the City.

If something isn't done they will continue to cause Contention (discord), Strife (judgment) and Reproach (confusion).

THE QUESTION BECOMES, HOW LONG WILL YOU ALLOW THEM TO SCORN (mock or scoff)?

Prov 1:22

22 **How long, ye simple** (foolish and seducible) **ones, will ye love simplicity** (being foolish and seduced)? **and the scorners delight in their scorning**, and fools hate knowledge?

THE ANSWER IS TO CAST THEM OUT (expel them):

Prov 22:10

10 **Cast out** (expel) **the scorner, and contention** (discord) **shall go out; yea, strife** (judgment) **and reproach** (confusion) **shall cease.**

THE FINAL JUDGMENT FOR SCORNERS, WILL COME FROM GOD:

Prov 9:12

12 If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but **if thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear it.**

Prov 3:34

34 **Surely he** (The Lord) **scorneth** (mocks or scoffs at) **the scorners:** but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

Prov 19:29

29 **Judgments** (infections or punishments) **are prepared for scorners,** and stripes for the back of fools.

Isa 29:20

20 **For the terrible one** (oppressor) **is brought to nought** (an end), **and the scorner is consumed** (utterly destroyed), and all that watch for iniquity (evil) are cut off (down or asunder):

Amen!

Prov 21:24

Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who
dealeth in proud wrath.

Ps 1:1

1 **Blessed** (How happy) **is the man that walketh not in the counsel** (advice or purpose) **of the ungodly, nor standeth** (abides or remains) **in the way of sinners, nor sitteth** (sits down or inhabits) **in the seat** (dwelling place) **of the scornful** (3887-luwts).

WHAT IS A SCORNER?

The Dictionary states:

A Scornor is one who shows open or unqualified contempt or disdain. The expression of such is displayed in an attitude in their behavior or speech. To Scorn is to express contempt; to scoff; to mock; to jeer.

In the Hebrew:

A Scornor is: **3887 luwts** (loots);
Properly, to make mouths at, to scoff.
KJV-- make a mock, mocker, Scornor.

THE SCORNER IS AN UNGODLY WITNESS AND AN ABOMINATION TO MANKIND:

Prov 19:28

28 **An ungodly witness scorneth judgment** (divine law or justice): and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

Prov 24:9

9 The thought of foolishness is sin: and **the scornor is an abomination** (disgusting morally) **to men** (mankind).

SCORNFUL RULERS CAN CAUSE WHOLE CITIES TO HAVE PROBLEMS:

Prov 29:8

8 **Scornful men bring a city into a snare** (or set a city aflame): but wise men turn away wrath.

Isa 28:14

14 **Wherefore hear the word of the LORD, ye scornful men, that rule** (govern) **this people** which is in Jerusalem.

THE SCORNER SEEKS WISDOM BUT CANNOT FIND IT!

Prov 14:6

6 **A scornor seeketh wisdom, and findeth it not:** but knowledge is easy unto him that understandeth.

THE SCORNER WILL NOT LISTEN TO REPROOF, REBUKE OR CORRECTION:

Prov 13:1

1 A wise son heareth his father's instruction: but **a scornor heareth not rebuke** (reproof).

Prov 15:12

12 **A scornor loveth not one that reproveth** (rebukes or corrects) **him:** neither will he go unto the wise.

THEREFORE DO NOT REPROVE, REBUKE OR CORRECT A SCORNER.

Prov 9:7

7 **He that reproveth** (corrects) **a scornor getteth to himself shame** (dishonor): and he that rebuketh (reproves or corrects) a wicked man getteth (only gives) himself a blot.

Prov 9:8

8 **Reprove not a scornor, lest he** (personally) **hate thee:** rebuke (reprove or correct) a wise man, and he will love thee.

RATHER THAN REPROOF, THE SCORNER NEEDS TO BE PUNISHED:

Prov 19:25

25 **Smite** (punish) **a scornor, and the simple** (foolish) **will beware** (become wary): and reprove (correct) one that hath understanding, and he will understand knowledge.

Prov 21:11

11 **When the scornor is punished, the simple** (foolish) **is made wise** (wiser): and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge.
