

THE GLORY OF THE LORD



Rev 10:1

And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun,

INTRODUCTION: THE RAINBOW:

The Rainbow in the cloud is a reminder of the covenant between God and man, that there will be no more floods that will destroy all flesh.. It is fashioned after the Rainbow that is over the throne in Heaven. That likeness is of “The Glory of the Lord”.

Gen 9:13-16

13 **I do set my bow in the cloud**, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.

14 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, **that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:**

15 And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.

16 **And the bow shall be in the cloud;** and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth.

Rev 4:3

3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and **there was a rainbow round about the throne**, in sight like unto an emerald.

Ezek 1:26-28

26 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it.

27 And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, **and it had brightness round about.**

28 **As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.** And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

THE GLORY OF THE LORD ON INDIVIDUALS:

Isa 60:1-2

1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and **the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.**

2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but **the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.**

Isa 58:8

8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; **the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.** (Rear-guard)

Ezek 3:23

23 Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, **the glory of the**

LORD stood there, as the glory which I saw by the river of Chebar:...

Luke 2:9

9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and **the glory of the Lord shone round about them:** and they were sore afraid.

2 Cor 3:18

18 But we all, with open face **beholding** as in a glass **the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.**

2 Cor 4:6

6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, **to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.**

Isa 40:5 (At His 2nd Coming Luke 3:5-6)

5 **And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together:** for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

THE “GLORY OF THE LORD” AS THE APPEARANCE OF THE RAINBOW, IS COMING TO THE TRUE CHURCH, (THE BODY OF CHRIST), IN THESE LAST DAYS:

Isa 35:1-2

1 The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

2 It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, **they shall see the glory of the LORD**, and the excellency of our God.

IKing 8:11 (Exodus 40:34-35)

11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: **for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.**

Ps 138:5

5 Yea, they shall sing in the ways of the LORD: **for great is the glory of the LORD.**

Ezek 43:1-2

1 Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east:

2 And, **behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east:** and his voice was like a noise of many waters: **and the earth shined with his glory.**

7 And he said unto me, **Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell** in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places.

Ezek 43:9

9 Now let them put away their whoredom, and the carcasses of their kings, far from me, **and I will dwell in the midst of them for ever.**

Exod 24:16-18

16 **And the glory of the LORD abode** upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

17 **And the sight of the glory of the LORD was like devouring fire** on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.

18 And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and gat him up into the mount: and Moses was in the mount forty days and forty nights.

CONCLUSION:

Jesus is “The Glory of the Lord”: and the Rainbow is as the appearance of His likeness; “The Glory of the Lord”!!

Heb 1:1-3

1 **God**, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

2 **Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 **Who being the brightness of his glory**, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Rev 21:9-11

9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, **I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.**

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, **the holy Jerusalem**, descending out of heaven from God,

11 **Having the glory of God**: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

Rev 21:22-23

22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: **for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.**
