

THE SCORNER



Prov 21:24

Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who
dealeth in proud wrath.

INTRODUCTION:

The Scorners are proud and haughty persons that cause contention (discord), strife (judgment) and reproach (confusion). This tract has been written to open the eyes of Christian leaders and the 'Body of Christ', to help them realize that something needs to be done with this type of person. The Scorners cannot be ignored, because the problems they cause will not go away. If you try to rebuke them, it won't help, because they won't listen to you. The sooner you begin to follow God's plan for the Scorners, the sooner you will help resolve the problems they cause in your cities, churches and homes.

Ps 1:1

1 **Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.**

What is a Scorners?

The Dictionary states:

A Scorners is one who shows open or unqualified contempt or disdain. The expression of such is displayed in an attitude in their behavior or speech. To Scorn is to express contempt; to scoff; to mock; to jeer.

In the Hebrew:

A Scorners is: 3887 luwts (loots); Properly, to make mouths at, to scoff. KJV-- make a mock, mocker, Scorners.

The Scorners is an ungodly witness and an abomination to men:

Prov 19:28

28 **An ungodly witness scorneth judgment:** and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

Prov 24:9

9 **The thought of foolishness is sin: and the scorners is an abomination to men.**

Scornful rulers can cause whole cities problems:

Prov 29:8

8 **Scornful men bring a city into a snare:** but wise men turn away wrath.

Isa 28:14

14 **Wherefore hear the word of the LORD, ye scornful men, that rule this people** which is in Jerusalem.

The Scorners seek wisdom, but cannot find it! **Prov 14:6**

6 **A scorner seeketh wisdom, and findeth it not:** but knowledge is easy unto him that understandeth.

The Scorners will not listen to Reproof or Rebuke:

Prov 13:1

1 A wise son heareth his father's instruction: but **a scorner heareth not rebuke.**

Prov 15:12

12 **A scorner loveth not one that reproveth him:** neither will he go unto the wise.

Therefore do not Reprove or Rebuke a Scorners.

Prov 9:7

7 **He that reproveth a scorner getteth to himself shame:** and he that rebuketh a wicked man getteth himself a blot.

Prov 9:8

8 **Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee:** rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

Rather than reproof, the Scorners need to be punished:

Prov 19:25

25 **Smite a scorner, and the simple will beware:** and reprove one that hath understanding, and he will understand knowledge.

Prov 21:11

11 **When the scorner is punished, the simple is made wise:** and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge.

CONCLUSION:

Scorners should not be ignored. They need to be dealt with whether in the Home, the Church or the City. If something isn't done, they will continue to cause Contention (discord), Strife (judgment) and Reproach (confusion).

The question is, how long will you allow them to Scorn?

Prov 1:22

22 **How long,** ye simple ones, **will ye love simplicity?** and **the scorners delight in their scorning,** and fools hate knowledge?

The answer is to cast them out (expel them):

Prov 22:10

10 **Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out;** yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

The final judgment for Scorners, will be from God:

Prov 9:12

12 If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but if thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear it.

Prov 3:34

34 Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

Prov 19:29

29 Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools.

Isa 29:20

20 For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off:
